Private tours of Rome's most eminent venues

EGYPTIAN ROME

This unique itinerary will reveal the striking presence of Egyptian monuments and works of art in the Eternal city, shining light on the unique relationship between the two powers by introducing guests to the plentiful amount of decorative Egyptian obelisks erected throughout the historical centre, and visiting the mysterious pyramid situated in the southern part of the city. The selection will be concluded in Piazza del Campidoglio, where guests will indulge in the masterful Statue of the River-God Nile. *Duration 3 hours.*

THE ORIGINS OF CHRISTIAN FAITH

This itinerary will disclose the extraordinary adventure and history of the Christian religion, from a small sect persecuted by the Roman government to a state religion that changed the history of our times. Accompanied by a private art historian, guests will visit the sites where this religion was founded and developed in order to understand its strong links with the pagan world, including Case Romane del Celio, Santa Costanza, and Santa Prassede. *Duration 3 hours*.

ROMAN VILLAS: A CULTURE OF PROSPERITY AND PROMINENCE

This selection will introduce guests to three of the many marvellous villas situated in the Eternal City. Accompanied by a private guide, guests will visit the 16th century Villa Farnesina facing the Tiber river, where they will indulge in the architecture as well as Raphael's incredible frescoes. The itinerary will continue to Villa Borghese, the baroque masterpiece situated in the midst of the park, before concluding with a visit to Villa Torlonia, from the 17th century, under which a Jewish cemetery was discovered in the beginning of the 20th century. *Duration 3 hours*.

BORROMINI: THE MYSTERIOUS GENIUS OF BAROQUE ROME

Accompanied by a private art historian, this selection will take guests on an intimate journey in the search for Borromini's soft signature curves of the master's architectural achievements as preserved in churches, chapels, crypts, and cloisters throughout the city, among which the Oratorio of San Filippo Neri, San Carlo alle Quattro Fontane, and Sant'Ivo alla Sapienza. *Duration 3 hours*.
